

## EIM Unusual Activity Alert for DM

### What is it and what are the benefits?

Unusual Activity Alert for DM sends email alerts to an administrator when certain DM activities are deemed "unusual" or "suspicious". Based on pre-set thresholds, such as high volume check-outs, exports or emails being sent, these alerts enable an administrator to identify and mitigate the removal of content within the DM.

- The list of activities that can be tracked is vast – below is a sample of the most important ones.
